5. Participants are not allowed to use gadgets like mobile phones, computers, cameras etc.
6. All participants must adhere to the rules and maintain discipline and decorum on the campus. Participants must follow the schedule and take part in all activities meant for them.
7. There is no charge for participation, food, accommodation etc. during the intensives. However, the teams will have to make their own arrangements to reach Coimbatore. Pickups and drops will be facilitated from the nearest railway station.

8. The participants must reach on Saturday 13th October before 11 am and must leave after 3 pm on Sunday 14th October, 2018.
